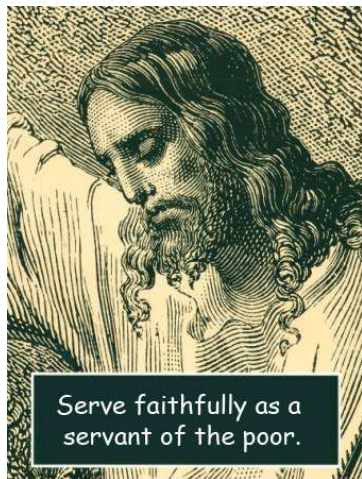


Our Mission

Services

The Haven at 115 Wilson Street, Newark, Ohio, can comfortably shelter 24 adult males for up to 2 years.

What we provide?

- Three meals a day (2 in-house and 1 packed)
- Toiletries
- Shelter from 4 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Clothing
- A mailing address
- Laundry facilities
- Access to a phone and voice mail
- Locked areas for prescription drugs/ personal items
- Showering facilities
- A computer room
- Taxi tokens
- Referral to appropriate community \ resources

Uniqueness

The SVdP Haven differs from other housing programs as we offer:

- Mentoring
- Website
- Computer access and classes
- Involvement from university students



Sobering Statistics

According to the USA Today in 2007, one in four homeless were veterans, but veterans make up only 11% of the entire population.

- Current estimates are that on any given night, there are more than 131,000 homeless veterans.

- According the Department of Veterans Affairs, the number of homeless Vietnam-era veterans is greater than service persons who died during that war.
- 80% of the homeless have significant mental health problems.
- Many homeless persons are among the working poor.
- Many who work 27 hours +/-week are at or below the official poverty level.
- One in four homeless persons is employed full or part time.
- Homeless population grows annually.
